## PUBLIC OPEN HOUSES

The City will be hosting an open house on Thursday April 22nd from 9:30 am to 4:30 pm and again from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm on the following projects:

1. **2010 Watermain CIPP relining** on Balmoral Avenue from Pitt to East limit, Station Road from Balmoral to North limit, Gage Avenue from New to Balmoral and Windsor Street from Kensington to Balmoral. This project will involve installation of a cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) liner into the existing pipe and restoration of access pits to match existing surface conditions. The pipe is a structural liner bonded to the cast iron host pipe. The use of trenchless technology provides a new pipe but with reduced property access disruptions, tree removals and other construction impacts. The project is tentatively scheduled to be done between June and August 2010.

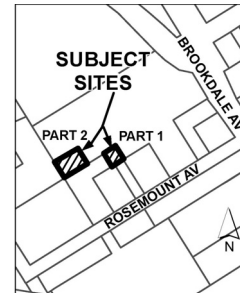
2. **Installation of Watermain** on Brookdale Avenue, Tollgate Road to Cornwall Centre Road. This project will include 2.1 km of 300 mm diameter watermain, with crossings at CN main line, Highway 401 and South Branch Raisin River. Funded in equal parts by the Federal, Provincial and City of Cornwall contributions, the project will improve reliability of the distribution supply to the north end of Cornwall and Cornwall Township, as well as improve development opportunities along this corridor. The project is tentatively scheduled to be done between September and November 2010.

Engineering staff will be available to answer questions and provide additional information about these projects. Everyone is welcome to attend.

## PLANNING ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING

The City of Cornwall Planning Advisory and Hearing Committee will hold a Public meeting on Monday, May 17th at 7:00 pm in the Council Chambers at City Hall. The purpose of the meeting is to consider the following Zoning By-law Amendment:

1. An application for zoning changes resulting from a land swap, which was recently approved at a Committee of Adjustment hearing and which is being heard at the above noted meeting. Part (1) One is being rezoned from Manufacturing 10 (MFR 10) to Highway Commercial (C.H.) zoning with Community Commercial Uses (C.C.) while Part (2) Two will be changed to a Manufacturing 10 (MFR 10) zone from the Highway Commercial (C.H.), with Community Commercial uses (C.C.) zoning. This rezoning will recognize a lot addition to the commercial property at 1236 Brookdale Avenue, as well as, a lot addition to the manufacturing property at 711 Rosemount Avenue. The site is legally described as Part of Lot 13, Concession 2 and is municipally known as 1236 Brookdale Avenue and 711 Rosemount Avenue.
