OPEN HOUSE INFORMATION SESSION

The City is hosting an Open House Information Session on Thursday, April 7th from 9 am to 12 pm, 1:30 pm to 4:30 pm and 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm at 1225 Ontario Street. The City is seeking comments and will be answering questions on the proposed construction of Pine Street from Seymore Avenue to Cumberland Street and of Jobin Avenue from the west limit to Aubin Avenue.



The project will include the replacement of the combined sewers (with separated storm and sanitary sewers), watermain, as well as service laterals from the main line to the property line. All surface works including roadway and sidewalks will be reconstructed. The project is tentatively scheduled to be done between mid May and early September 2011.

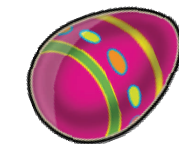
