TRANSIT FARE INCREASE

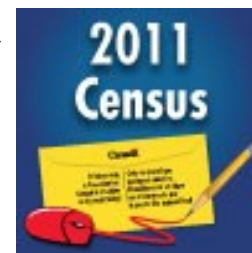
