WASTE AND BLUEBOX WINTER REGULATIONS

- Residents are responsible for their garbage and blue box until final collection.
- Do not place solid waste or blue box material on top of snow banks.
- Placement area must be shoveled to ground level and must be kept clear for collection personnel
- Solid waste and blue box material are not to be placed in the street or on the sidewalk
- During winter conditions, it is the responsibility of residents to remove/unbury solid waste and blue box material from the snow
- In order to avoid missed collections, garbage and recycling must be placed at the curb by 7 a.m. on your pickup day.
