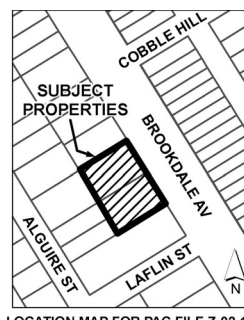

PUBLIC MEETING - PAC

The City of Cornwall Planning Advisory and Hearing Committee will hold a public meeting on Monday, March 15, 2010 at 7 pm, in the Council Chambers at City Hall. The purpose of the meeting is to consider the following Official Plan/Zoning By-law Amendments.

1. An application for a Zoning By-law amendment to change the Zoning from Residential 15 (RES 15) to Residential 20 (RES 20) to allow for the construction of two four-plex multi-unit dwellings. The lands subject to this rezoning are located along Brookdale Avenue North of Laflin Street. The property is legally described as Lots 2 and 3, of Registered Plan 240, in the City of Cornwall.

OPEN HOUSE SESSIONS

The City of Cornwall Planning Division will be hosting two scheduled Open House Sessions to introduce its draft proposal for a new Community Commercial-Shopping Centre (CC-SC) zone, revised Neighbourhood Commercial (CN) zone and related Official Plan Amendment to incorporate a special policy.

The new CC-SC zone is intended to eventually replace the present Community Commercial zoned sites within the City. Over the course of the past several years, the Planning Division has experienced a shift in emphasis to multi-tenant/multi-purpose Commercial Power Centre projects. These projects typically have a broad multi range of uses including but not limited to general/specialized retail stores, service shops, office space, eating establishments and commonly designed on several building pad envelopes on one parcel of land.

Numerous properties will be considered for this new zone (including some sites with a Holding category) and total approximately 26 sites at varying degrees of development with a present total aggregate Gross Leasable Area in the range of 1.4 million square feet.

A revised Neighbourhood Commercial zone will also be considered for a total of approximately 8 sites within the City, some of which have Hybrid zoning (i.e. a mix of two different commercial zones) and with a present total aggregate Gross Leasable Area in the range of 59,000 square feet.

The Open House Sessions are an opportunity to dialogue and exchange ideas on the Zoning/Official Plan Amendment proposals with Planning staff on an informal basis. This is prior to a required public meeting in front of the Planning Advisory Committee (PAC).

PUBLIC MEETING - YORK STREET RECONSTRUCTION

The City is proposing to undertake the reconstruction of York Street from Third Street to Fourth Street.

The project will include replacement of the combined sewer (with separated storm and sanitary sewers), watermain, as well as service laterals from the main line to the property line. All surfaced work including roadway and sidewalks will be reconstructed. The project is tentatively scheduled to be done between late April and mid July 2010.

The public's input is sought. During the meeting sidewalk construction options including adding a sidewalk on the west side will be reviewed.
