City of Cornwall Planning Advisory Committee

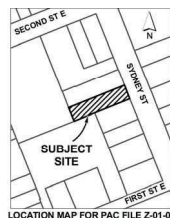
The City of Cornwall Planning Advisory and Hearing Committee (PAC) will hold a Public meeting on **Tuesday, February 17, 2009 at 7:00 p.m.**, in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 340 Pitt Street, Cornwall. The purpose of the meeting is to consider the following:

**1.** An application for a Draft Plan of Condominium for the Cornwall COTTON MILL LOFTS which will consist of 60 residential units, with 82 parking spaces. The site is located at 710 Cotton Mill Street, City of Cornwall, legally described as Part of Lot 7 Concession 1 and Part of Lot 150, Registered Plan No. 16. The file numbers for this development are CD-2009-01 and Condominium Folder 273. The property to which this application refers to is depicted in the subject map.
