## NOTICE TO BUSINESS OWNERS

Under the Business Licensing By-laws, business owners and/or operators must annually renew their Business License.

**Licenses must be obtained before February 1st.**

If you have not done so please call our office to begin the initial process. Below is a quick list of the categories which require a Business License:

Adult Entertainment (Attendant, Establishment, Retail), Amusement Exhibition (Tent, Open Air), Amusement Place, Auctioneer, Auto Repair & Garages, Bed and Breakfast, Body Rub Parlour (Owner/Operator, Attendant), Christmas Tree Vendor, Dry Cleaning Depot, Eating Establishment, Escort Service (Owner/Operator, Attendant), Food Premises, Hair Dressing Establishment, Hobby Exhibition (Tent, Open Air, Indoor), Holistic Practitioners, Mobile Food Premises (Canteen, Chip Truck, Hot Dogs, Ice Cream), Pawnbroker, Personal Service Facility, Pet Stores, Recycling Facility, Retail Exhibition, Rickshaw, Salesperson, Seasonal Stationary Food Premises, Second Hand Goods, Tobacco, Transient Photographer.

Initial Licenses must be obtained for any new businesses listed above, and/or when there is a change of owner or a change of address. There is no discount for licenses that cover a partial year.
