SAFETY & ETIQUETTE ON RECREATIONAL PATH

Users should always be mindful of others when using the City recreational path. Keep to the right and move completely off the pathway when stopping. Users should pass only on the left side of the pathway when it is safe to do so, and they should also call out a warning before passing.
