SUMMER BY-LAW TIPS

Swimming is prohibited at all times within 200' of the boat launches at Lamoureux Park and at Guindon Park. A fine for such an offence is \$105.



The City of Cornwall has two By-laws in effect which prohibits all people from littering.

Littering By-law: no person shall throw place or deposit refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality.

Streets By-law: no person shall blow, rake sweep or throw debris, ashes, dirt, and other rubbish on any street, park or other public property. For more information please visit the City's website.

OUTDOOR AQUATIC FACILITY CLOSURES

The City of Cornwall's Department of Planning, Parks and Recreation would like to advise our aquatic patrons that effective summer 2010 the following outdoor aquatic facilities will be permanently closed:

- Adams Park wading pool
- Alexander Park wading pool
- St. Theresa's Park wading pool
- Kinsmen Park large and wading pools

These pools have served our community well and have now come to the end of their useful lifespan. In the near future, the City of Cornwall will be redeveloping Kinsmen Park with the addition of a basketball court, new play structure, pathways and refurbished washrooms and adding a splash pad to St. Theresa's Park.

Your continued patronage is important to us. The City operates 6 outdoor pools for swimming lessons and leisure swimming. The Cornwall Aquatic Centre is also available throughout the year for daily, evening and weekend lessons and leisure swimming.
