PUBLIC MEETING

The City of Cornwall Advisory and Hearing Committee (PAC) will hold a Public meeting on Monday, July 20, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers of City Hall. The purpose of the meeting is to consider the following Zoning By-law and/or Official Plan Amendment(s) or other matters(s).

A City initiated request to remove the Holding (H) category on By-law 182-2008 since the reason(s) for the Hold(H) have been fulfilled. The site on which this By-law applies is located on a portion of the former DOMTAR property with frontage on Seventh Street West. The subject site has been rezoned to Open Space 10 (OSP 10) for the specific 15 acre portion within the larger 36-acre parcel north of Second Street West (includes part of the former wood processing area). This request is in support of the redevelopment proposal for a multi-sport complex facility on the former industrial property. The site is described legally as Part of Lots 13 and 14, Concession 1, City of Cornwall.

The property to which this application applies is indicated by the hatched area on the map.
