### ZONING BY-LAW 2010-031

Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cornwall passed By-law 2010-031 on Monday, March 22, 2010, under Chap. P13, s.34(18)(19) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 as amended; and

Take notice that any person or agency may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board in respect of the By-law by filing, with the Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Cornwall no later than Thursday, April 15, 2010, a Notice of Appeal setting out the objections to the By-law and the reasons in support of the objection.

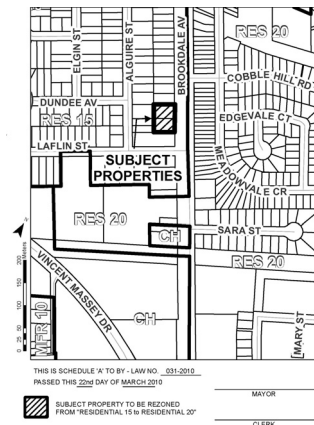
An explanation of the purpose and effect of the By-law describing those lands to which the By-law applies is found below. The complete By-law is available for inspection in the Clerk's Office during regular office hours.

#### Explanation of The Purpose and Effect of By-law 2010-031

The purpose and effect of By-law 2010-031 is to rezone the property situated along Brookdale Avenue, North of Lafflin Street, being Lots 2 and 3 on Registered Plan No. 240 to Residential 20 (RES 20) from Residential 15 (RES 15) to allow for the construction of a four-plex on each lot.

The site subject to this rezoning is identified on the map.



### PITT STREET CLOSURE

Pitt Street will be closed to northbound traffic at Tollgate Road starting Monday, April 5. The Pitt Street Bridge over the South Branch Raisin River is scheduled for major rehabilitation work. The closure will last approximately 13 weeks.

Northbound traffic will be rerouted east to McConnell Avenue. The bridge on Pitt Street will remain open to southbound traffic for the duration of the construction period.
