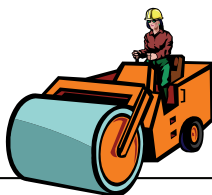

Swimming Lessons

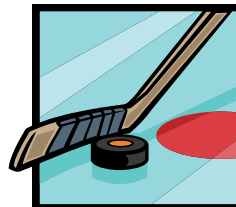
