BY-LAW REMINDERS

The City of Cornwall would like to remind its residents of a few By-Laws as the weather gets warmer.

- No littering on City property and streets: We appreciate your cooperation in keeping your city clean by complying with the no littering By-laws. Garbage bins have been added throughout the City to ensure its tidiness.
- Stoop and Scoop: Please remember to bring a bag when you bring your dog for a walk and stoop and scoop. You can be fined if you leave any feces on public or private property.
- Skateboards: Skateboarding is prohibited in certain areas of the city. Find out where you can skateboard by calling the Cornwall Community Police Service.
- No Swimming At The Boat Launch: The City has a By-law which prohibits swimming at the boat launch in Lamoureux Park. No person or pet is permitted to swim within 200 feet of the boat launch ramp. Signs have been posted and fines will apply to those who do not adhere to the By-law.



PITT STREET CLOSURE

Pitt Street will be closed to northbound traffic at Tollgate Road starting Monday, April 5. The Pitt Street Bridge over the South Branch Raisin River is scheduled for major rehabilitation work. The closure will last approximately 13 weeks.

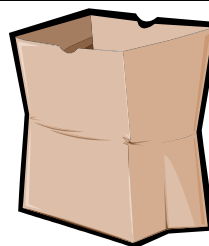
Northbound traffic will be rerouted east to McConnell Avenue. The bridge on Pitt Street will remain open to southbound traffic for the duration of the construction period.
