Garbage scheduled to be collected on May 18th will be picked up on Tuesday May 19th.

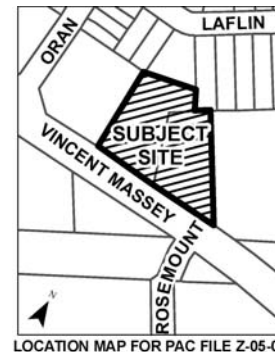


NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING - ZONING BY-LAW

The City of Cornwall Planning Advisory and Hearing Committee (PAC) will hold a Public meeting on Monday June 15, 2009 at 7:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The purpose of the meeting is to consider the following Zoning By-law and/or Official Plan Amendment(s).

An application for an Official Plan Amendment for a site specific exception to the "General Commercial" (G.C.) designation and a Rezoning to the Highway Commercial (C.H.) zone for a site specific exception to allow for a private school (Ontario Hockey Academy) and associated dormitory. The property is the former Jazz Magnolia's Bar/Restaurant and Days Inn building at 1539 and 1541 Vincent Massey Drive, respectively. The property is legally described as Part Lots 13 and 14 Concession 2, as shown on Reference Plan 52R-3504. The file number for this application is Z-05-09.
