### EXPLANATION OF PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF BY-LAW 055-2009

The purpose and effect of the Temporary Use By-law is to permit the establishment of Business and Professional offices in the property located on Part of Lot B, Concession 1, being Parts 2, 3 and 4 on Plan 52R-1509, municipally known as 3304 Second Street East. The business or professional office(s) will be limited to a maximum of 5,000 square feet of gross leasable area to be located in the front portion of the building, and including the first and second floors. This temporary use by-law shall remain in effect for a period of three(3) years.

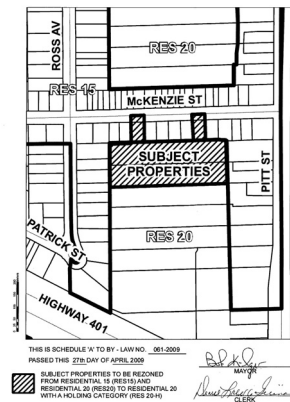

### EXPLANATION OF PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF BY-LAW 061-2009

The purpose and effect of the By-law is to apply the Holding (H) provision on the Residential 15 (RES 15) and Residential 20 (RES 20) zone so as to prevent any premature development until such time as appropriate subdivision plans can be put into place.

The site subject to this rezoning is identified on schedule A attached hereto.



## PARKING PRIVILEGES FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

A by-law was passed on March 23, 2009 stating that:

1. That parking at all on-street metered zones, and off-street paid parking at all municipal public parking lots be provided free of charge for disabled people.
2. That parking at any time-limited on-street and off-street parking zone be extended to three (3) hours maximum for disabled people, regardless of the time limit displayed by official signs or other means.
