Cornwall Transit will be offering a free shuttle service to and from the H1N1 Immunization Clinics being held at General Vanier Intermediate School (1500 Cumberland Street North).

Shuttles will leave every 30 minutes from Eastcourt Mall at the United Furniture Warehouse entrance and the Brookdale Centre/Wal-mart bus stop near Tim Hortons. It will travel directly to the clinic location. This service will be available during all clinic times.

No registration will be accepted after December 4th. A clearance certificate from W.S.I.B. showing that you are in good standing with the board and a copy of your ownership and CVOR numbers must be supplied at registration.

All owners and operators of the trucks must comply with all CVOR regulations. Rates are to be in accordance with the City of Cornwall formulas for snow hauling.
