NOTICE OF PASSING OF ZONING BY-LAW

Take notice that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Cornwall passed By-law 2010-116 on Monday, September 27, 2010, under Chap. P13, s.34 (18)(19) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 as amended; and

Take notice that any person or agency may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board in respect of the By-law by filing with the Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Cornwall no later than Thursday, October 21, 2010, a Notice of Appeal setting out the objections to the By-law and the reasons in support of the objection.

An explanation of the purpose and effect of the By-law describing those lands to which the By-law applies or, alternatively, an explanation as to why key map is not provided are attached. The complete By-law is available for inspection in the Clerk's Office hours.

Explanation of purpose and effect of By-law 2010-116

The purpose and effect of the By-law 2010-116 is to introduce one further textual modification into the City's comprehensive Zoning By-law Number 751, 1969, as amended. A summary of the item is listed below:

In sub-section **01-4 SETBACK**, add a new sub-section 01-4-7 - **Setback Provision for Private Outdoor Above-Ground Pools with Associated Decks** to include a provision for above-ground pools, with associated decks around such pools, that have a height of greater than 1.2m (4 feet) to be situated 1.5m (5 feet) from the interior side and rear yards and not closer than 6m (19.68 feet) to any exterior lot line adjacent to a street.
