All owners and operators of the trucks must comply with all CVOR regulations. Rates are to be in accordance with the City of Cornwall formulas for snow hauling.

Come join us for sports, active games, crafts, activities, swimming, field trips and a whole lot more. November 20th, full day. **P.S. No homework allowed!**

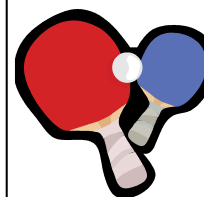


Table Tennis
