FALL LEAF AND YARD WASTE

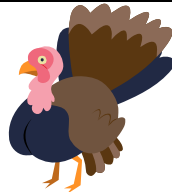
From October 19 to November 20, the City of Cornwall will be collecting leaf and yard waste in compostable paper bags or returnable containers only.

SNOW FACILITY - END OF STUDY

The City of Cornwall has completed a Class Environmental Assessment to review the future status of the City's existing Snow Disposal Facility (SDF) on Water Street West. Improvement to the existing Snow Disposal Facility or a new facility at a new location is required to accommodate the City's snow disposal needs. This study included a review of possible enhancement / modification of the existing facility and a review of potential sites for a new facility within Cornwall. Ecoplans Limited undertook this study on behalf of the City of Cornwall.

The study followed the environmental planning process for Schedule 'B' projects pursuant to the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA), which is approved under the *Ontario Environmental Assessment Act*.

A key component of the study was consultation with interested stakeholders (public and agencies), including a Public Information Centre held on February 18, 2009 to introduce the project, present the long list of potential site areas and describe the screening process used to identify a preferred site. Following the PIC held on February 19, 2009 and additional consultation with interested stakeholders, the preferred plan has been confirmed. The preferred plan involves:

Relocating the existing snow disposal facility on Water Street West to a new location at Virginia Drive and the CN Rail line as shown in the key plan. Implementing a meltwater management plan to minimize impacts from the City's snow disposal operations.

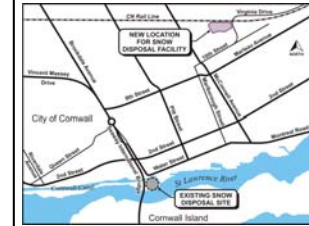
A preliminary concept plan and a preliminary meltwater management plan have been developed. These preliminary plans will be further developed during the subsequent detail design stage.

A Project File has been completed and will be available for a 30-day public review period from October 5, 2009 to November 4, 2009. The Project File is available for review at the following locations during regular business hours:

Requests for Part II Order must be received by the Minister, at the address noted below, by November 4, 2009. A copy of the request must also be sent to the City of Cornwall at the address noted below. If no request is received by November 4, 2009, the City of Cornwall intends to proceed with detail design and construction as outlined in the Project File.
