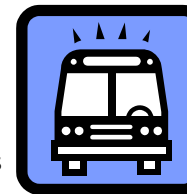

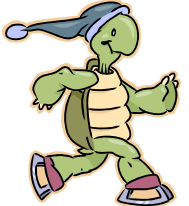

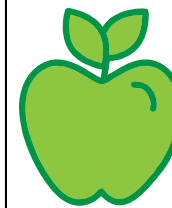


P.A. Day Camp - 5 to 12 years, September 25

Come and join us for an awesome sports, active games, cool crafts and activities, swimming, field trips and a whole lot more. Don't forget your swimsuit and towel.

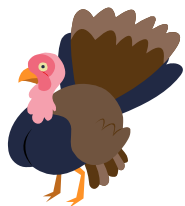
Tiny Tots - 2 to 5 years
