

BY-LAW NO. 028-2000 OF THE CITY OF CORNWALL


A by-law to prohibit the discharge of guns,
or other firearms, cross bows or long bows
or any classes or type thereof and that
this By-law shall be known as
The Firearms By-law.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M 11, Section 210, paragraph 36, provides that a by-law may be passed for prohibiting or regulating the discharge of guns and other firearms, air guns, spring guns, cross bows, long bows or any class or type thereof.

THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cornwall enacts as follows:


1. No person shall discharge a gun, or other firearms, air guns, spring guns, cross bows, long bows, or any class or type thereof in the municipality.
2. Section 1 shall not apply if a gun or bow or classes of, are discharged in approved shooting range.
3. The discharge of blank ammunition is permissible only with written permission of the Chief of Police.
4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P. 33, as amended
5. By-Law No. 028-1986 shall be and the same is hereby repealed.


