# SEASONAL STATIONARY FOOD PREMISES

### DEFINITION:

Seasonal Stationary Food Premise shall mean a business where food is sold for consumption by the public and where this business closes its operation for more than 90 consecutive days on a yearly basis.

**EXAMPLE:** Where food is sold.

### THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION/ITEMS MUST BE PROVIDED:

- Initial Business License Application Fee
- Completed Application Form
- Site Plan - Location and Details
- The required form of the Eastern Ontario Health Unit (E.O.H.U) filled out and signed by a representative of the E.O.H.U.
- Building and Plumbing permits
- Water and Sewer Permits (must connect to City Services)
- Certificate of approval from a licensed propane fitter, if equipped with propane
- Letter of permission from the land owner.
- Number of Picnic Tables \_\_\_\_\_

**INITIAL BUSINESS LICENSE FEE: \$ 175.00**
