NOTICE TO AFFECTED RESIDENCES

DISRUPTION OF WATER SERVICE

Please be advised that as a result of construction work on Robertson Avenue, your water service will be disrupted on Monday July 13th, 2020 commencing at approximately 8:00 AM.

Please make any necessary arrangements in order to prepare for the disruption. We anticipate that your water service will be reinstated before 6:00 PM, provided that unforeseen circumstances are not encountered.

Occasionally, some minor problems can occur after the water supply is reinstated.

- If water shows discoloration, run the water until it clears.
- If sputtering occurs, turn on every hot and cold faucet to remove air pockets from the water supply.
- If flow at a faucet is less than usual, remove the screen from the faucet, remove any obstructions and reinstall it.
