A MESSAGE FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR

Dear family and friends of GSDL,

As we are moving into an Endemic stage and finally starting to see the light at the end of the tunnel, I really want to thank all of you for your collaboration, words of affirmation and compassion towards the staff during these difficult and unprecedented last 24-months. This year, the Lodge is investing a total of \$2,9M in major capital improvements. Some of the major projects are: replacing our Air Handling System, installing a new generator, modernizing the 2nd passenger elevator, flooring repairs and replacement, upgrading our lighting to LED's, modernizing the resident's bathing and personal care room (starting with 4th floor), indoor furniture replacement as well as the replacement of all our washing machines. We are also happy to see that the province has made a commitment to investing more funding in Long Term Care Homes across the province and have committed in attaining 4 hours of resident care per day by 2025. This year, we have received an additional \$1,1M in staffing funding which represents approximately 12 new Full-Time positions. We hope that you will enjoy the quarterly newsletter. New Broda Elite Tilt Wheelchair

The Glen Stor Dun Lodge Foundation was approved to purchase a Broda Elite Tilt Wheelchair for use with residents requiring complex care, and palliative comfort needs.

The Broda Elite wheelchair provides exceptional comfort and range of tilt. The system provides pressure redistribution and airflow for increased sitting comfort and support. Featuring up to 40° of infinitely adjustable seat tilt, the wheelchair provides safe and comfortable positioning, decreasing the need for restraints.
