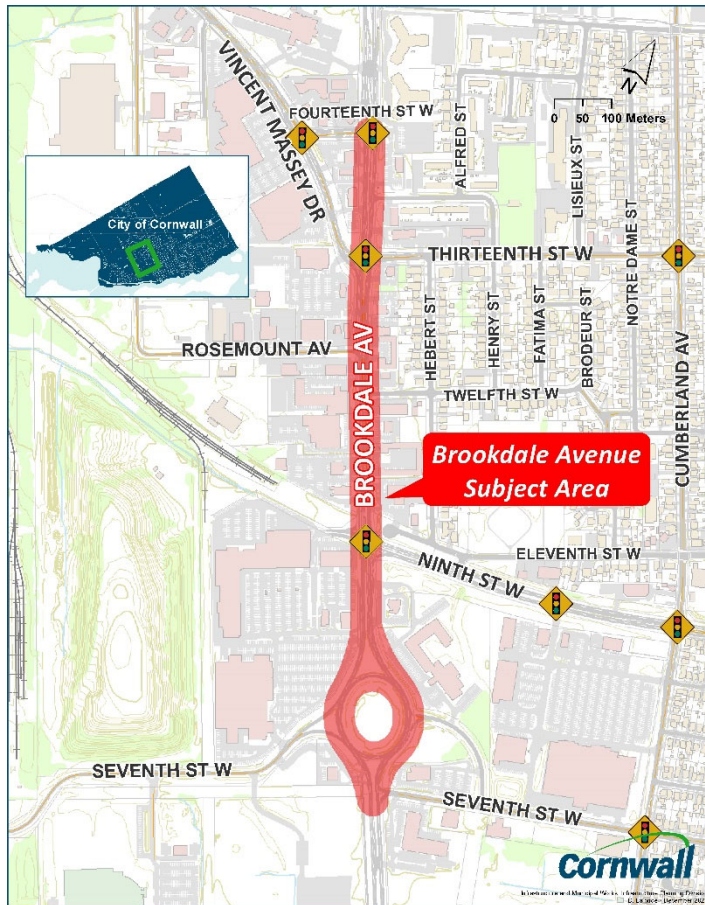


## Notice of Study Completion

### Cornwall Brookdale Avenue from Seventh Street to Fourteenth Street

### Municipal Class Environmental Assessment

The City of Cornwall has completed the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) for improvements to Brookdale Avenue between Seventh Street Court and Fourteenth Street West. The study was conducted as a Schedule C project under the MCEA process and has identified a preferred design to address transportation needs, enhance safety, and support active transportation along the corridor (see Figure below).



An Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been prepared to document the planning, consultation, and decision-making process undertaken for this project. The ESR is available for public review and comment for a period of 30 days, from November 10 to December 10, 2025, on the City of Cornwall website at [www.cornwall.ca](http://www.cornwall.ca). If you require the ESR in an alternate format, please contact a member of the project team.

In addition, a request may be made to the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks for an order requiring a higher level of study (i.e. requiring an comprehensive EA approval before being able to proceed), or that conditions be imposed (e.g. require further studies), only on the grounds that the requested order may prevent, mitigate or remedy adverse impacts on constitutionally protected Aboriginal and treaty rights. Requests on other grounds will not be considered. Requests should include the requester contact information and full name.

Requests should specify what kind of order is being requested (request for conditions or request for an individual/comprehensive environmental assessment), how an order may prevent, mitigate or remedy potential adverse impacts on Aboriginal and treaty rights, and any information in support of the statements in the request. This will ensure that the ministry is able to efficiently begin reviewing the request. The request should be sent in writing or by email to:
