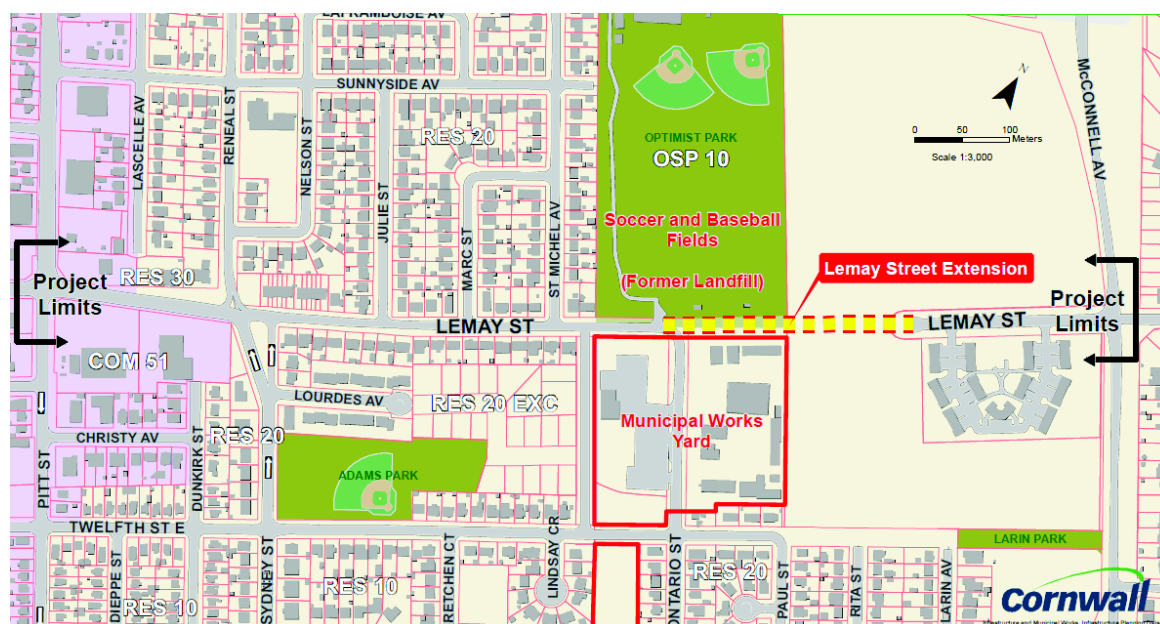


Notice of Study Commencement

Proposed Improvement and Extension of Lemay Street and the Redevelopment & Design of the Municipal Works Yard Class Environmental Assessment Study

The City of Cornwall has initiated a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for improvements and extension of Lemay Street from Pitt Street to McConnell Avenue. This study will be carried out in accordance with the requirements for a Schedule 'C' project under the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* document (2007, 2011). As part of the Lemay Street EA, a study to redevelop the Municipal Works Yard on Lemay Street will be carried out as Schedule 'B' project.

The purpose of the study is to conduct a detailed evaluation of future transportation demand for the east-west direction of travel in the area of Lemay Street. The study will assess current network deficiencies and will develop a recommended plan to address capacity, operational and safety issues while minimizing environmental impacts. The study area, which is subject to refinement during the EA process, is illustrated in the key map. The study will also review the existing facilities of the Municipal Works Yard and will develop a plan that will provide efficient operations in the future.



The EA process will involve developing, assessing, and evaluating alternatives, which will result in a recommended plan to be presented to the City of Cornwall Council and the public. The study is expected to be completed by the fall of 2015. Upon completion of this study, an Environmental Study Report will be available for public review and comment. A notice of study completion will be published at that time.

Public Information Centre

Public open houses will be held during the course of the study to provide an opportunity for the public to review and discuss the project with representatives of the Project Team. The first Public Information Centre (PIC) will be held:
