



Study Completion Notice Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for the Proposed Extension of Nick Kaneb Drive

The City of Cornwall has completed the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Proposed Extension of Nick Kaneb Drive. This study was completed as a Schedule "B" project under the Municipal Class EA. The Recommended Plan provides the City of Cornwall with an extension of Nick Kaneb Drive from Marleau Avenue and Tenth Street. The Recommended Plan provides the following beneficial elements; a new 2-lane roadway link, sidewalks, grassed boulevards, a recreational path, a conventional intersection at Tenth Street and provides improved connectivity to and from the Cornwall Business Park.

A Project File documenting the recommended plan effects anticipated by the project and the corresponding mitigation measures has been prepared and is being placed on the public record for public and agency review. A copy of the Project File is available for public review at the following location:
