These items are not biodegradable. They will stick together, to other items, and to the insides of your pipes, creating blockages.



These items may not cause blockages but they can contaminate the water system. The chemicals can poison aquatic environments, infiltrate drinking water, kill good bacteria or increase bacterial resistance to pharmaceuticals, and cause a host of other issues.

P pee
(toilet) poop
paper
