A By-law to amend the Traffic & Parking by-law 069-1989, Schedule II, Parking Restrictions, Schedule IV, Parking Restrictions-time limits, and Schedule VIII, Parking Meter Zones on York Street

Whereas By-law enforcement and residents brought to the City's attention certain issues regarding on-street parking on York Street.

Whereas the majority of respondents are in favour of the proposed changes.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Cornwall enacts as follows:

Pursuant to Sections 8, 9 & 11 of the Municipal Act and amendments;

Schedule II (Parking Restrictions) of the Traffic & Parking By-law No. 069-1989, and 016-2011 is amended by repealing thereto the following:

Highway	Side	Between	Prohibited Times or Days
York Street	West	53 metres south of First St. West and a point 134 metres further south	Anytime

Schedule IV, Parking Restrictions-time limits, of the Traffic & Parking By-law No. 069-1989, and 176-2003 is amended by repealing thereto the following:

Highway	Side	Between	Restricted Times or Days	Maximum Period Permitted
York Street	West	29 metres north of Water St. West and a point 14 metres further north	Anytime	15 min

Pursuant to Sections 8, 9 & 11 of the Municipal Act, and amendments;

Schedule II (Parking Restrictions) of the Traffic & Parking By-law No. 069-1989 is amended by adding thereto the following:

Highway	Side	Between	Prohibited Times or Days
York Street	West	89 metres south of First St. West and a point 45 metres further south	Anytime

Whereas following concerns about parking received from the residents, parking surveys were sent to residents of First Street between Amelia and Adolphus Street; and


Whereas the majority of the respondent residents support the proposed parking restrictions.





Whereas there is often significant presence of children around the proposed safety zone; and


Whereas community safety zones nearby schools help for the prevention and enforcement of moving violations.



58. No person shall cause a vehicle to be parked or left on private property without the express permission of the owner or occupant thereof.


And Section 56, "Unauthorised Parking Prohibited" of the of the Traffic & Parking By-law No. 069-1989, is amended by adding the following:



A By-law to further amend the Traffic and Parking By-law 069-89, Section 8.1 (g), "Parking prohibited without signs" and to repeal By-law 2016-203

Whereas, section 8.1 (g), restricts parking as follows; "No person shall on any highway park a vehicle or permit a vehicle to remain parked, subject to Section 13, for a period longer than seven (7) days";

Whereas, the purpose of the seven days restriction of section 8.1 (g), is mainly to prevent the long term presence of vehicles on the street.

Whereas by-law enforcement requested a shorter period of 24 hours, being more manageable for enforcement purposes; and still meet the purpose of the by-law.

Now there be it resolved that, pursuant to Sections 8, 9 & 11 of the Municipal Act. and amendments; Section 8.1 (g), "Parking prohibited without signs", of the Traffic & Parking By-law No. 069-1989, is amended by **repealing** the following By-law 2016-203:

Parking prohibited without signs.




