

April 12, 1977

A regular meeting of City Council was held this evening with the following members present - His Worship Mayor G. Parisien; Aldermen P. Armstrong, R. Aubry, G. Cameron, F. Guindon, L. Keen, L.G. Lavigne, A. Lebano, A. LeBlanc, B. Lynch, J. Pescod, G. Samson and G. Williamson.

Presentations -

E.C. Lumley, M.P. - A certificate of appreciation was presented to Mr. E.C. Lumley who served as Mayor of the City during the years 1972-3-4.

Basketball Team - Recognition was paid to members of the United Counties Girls Basketball Team - Janice Jodoin, team capt.; Helen Doll, All-Ontario team selection; Brenda Bedard, Ontario highest scorer; A. Haskavitz and D. Bergeron, coaches.

Adoption of Minutes - Moved by Aldermen Guindon and Lynch that the minutes of the Council meeting of March 28th be adopted as received. Carried

Moved by Aldermen LeBlanc and Samson that the minutes of the Committee of Council meeting of March 28th be adopted as received. Carried

Delegations-

Mr. Gerald Baron requested Council to give serious consideration to the authority provided in the Municipal Act to regulate trades in the City of Cornwall. His request is that local labour be hired in preference to out-of-town workers. City Council received his brief and informed Mr. Baron that his comments would be forwarded to the City solicitor for explanations.

Moved by Aldermen Lynch and Aubry that the Notice of Motion, as listed on the agenda, be approved and that a delegation be sent to Queen's Park to meet with the Minister of Labour. The delegation should consist of some members of Council, Mr. Baron and Mr. G. Samis, M.P.P. Carried

- 036- to authorize sale of land to O.H.C. (66' right-of-way north of City's proposed Land Assembly Program)

13. Recreation Committee - Moved by Aldermen Keen and Lynch that the minutes of the meeting of April 4th be adopted. Carried
14. Remuneration to Council members - Moved by Aldermen Guindon and Lynch that the Mayor and Council receive a 6% salary increase for the year 1977. Alderman Keen requested a recorded vote. Vote for the motion: Aldermen Cameron, Guindon, Lynch, Williamson and Aubry. Against the motion: Aldermen Armstrong, Pescod, Lebano, Lavigne, Keen, Samson and LeBlanc. Motion defeated.
15. 1976 Financial Statements - Moved by Aldermen Aubry and Lynch that the report of March 28th of the Chief Administrator be approved. Carried.

New Business -


