
Tender #52 - Moved by Aldermen Lynch and Pescod that the tender for the installation of sanitary sewers on various City streets be awarded to Clarence McDonald Excavations Ltd. at a price of \$51,729.5 with the condition that no construction be undertaken until approval has been received from the Ontario Municipal Board. Carried

Sluice Gates - Moved by Aldermen Samson and Guindon that administrative prepare tenders, on an invitational basis, for the installation of sluice gates at the Filtration Plant. Carried

Civic Complex plaques - The Mayor explained to the members of Council that some danger existed in transferring the plaques from their present location to the location approved earlier by Council. After some further discussion it was -
