Bicentennial Project

It was moved by Aldermen Lebano and Armstrong that Mrs. E. Senior be engaged to write the history of Cornwall at a cost of \$20,000 to be budgeted as follows - \$10,000 in 1979 and \$10,000 in 1980. Carried.

It was the consensus of Council that the following changes be made in the budget -

Remove \$10,000 from the Inverarden House project

Freeze Hiring

It was moved by Aldermen Williamson and Lalonde that no hiring take place in 1979 with the exception of the request for a social worker and police constables. Motion defeated.
