

CITY COUNCIL #19-80

July 14, 1980.

The Regular Meeting of City Council was held this evening when the following members were present - His Worship Mayor G. Parisien, Aldermen D. Armstrong, R. Aubry, G. Cameron, F. Guindon, L. Keen, R. Lalonde, A. Lebano, A. LeBlanc, B. Lynch, J. Pescod, G. Samson and G. Williamson.

ADOPTION OF MINUTES

Moved by Aldermen Lalonde and Lynch that the minutes of the June 30th meeting of Council be adopted. Carried

Moved by Aldermen Keen and LeBlanc that the minutes of the June 30th meeting of Committee of Council be adopted. Carried

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

Moved by Aldermen Lebano and Pescod that Council go into Committee of the Whole and that all delegations, resolutions, communications and by-laws be referred to that committee and that by-laws 93 to 95 be given first reading. Carried

- By-law 93 - To amend the Zoning By-law (Development Control)  
94 - To appoint members to Board of Management (Downtown BIA)  
95 - To authorize signing of agreement with Dept. of Transport (TCTI)

RESOLUTIONS

- #36 - Moved by Aldermen Pescod and Aubry that in spite of objection received Council still supports By-law No. 63, 1980. A recorded vote resulted as follows - For the Motion: Aldermen Armstrong, Pescod, Lebano, Lalonde, Guindon, LeBlanc and Aubry. Against the Motion: Aldermen Cameron, Keen, Lynch and Samson. Carried
- #37 - Moved by Aldermen Guindon and Lalonde that By-law No. 63, 1980 is in accordance with the Official Plan of the City of Cornwall and that the amendment to the Official Plan covering the lands in question has been approved by Council and is awaiting the approval of the Minister. A recorded vote resulted as follows - For the Motion: Aldermen Armstrong, Pescod, Lebano, Lalonde, Guindon, LeBlanc and Aubry. Against the Motion: Aldermen Cameron, Keen, Lynch and Samson. Carried
- #38 - Moved by Aldermen Lebano and Samson that Mayor G. Parisien, Mr. C.F. Adams, Aldermen G. Cameron and R. Lalonde be appointed voting delegates for the City of Cornwall at the 1980 AMO Annual Conference. Carried

 Moved by Aldermen Lynch and Pescod that the Consent Agenda be approved. Carried

COMMUNICATIONS

- 1. Tender #40-80 - Moved by Aldermen Lalonde and Cameron that the tender be awarded to Menard Structures at a price of \$27,696.25 for siding & eaves-trough at the Water Street Arena. Carried
- 2. Environmental Control Committee - Moved by Aldermen Guindon and Samson that the minutes of June 25th be received. Carried
- 3. Pedestrian Mall Commission - Moved by Aldermen Armstrong and Lynch that the minutes of July 9th be adopted. Defeated  
 An amendment was moved by Aldermen Cameron and Guindon that the report be deferred to the next meeting of Council. Carried
- 4. Boathouse Committee - Moved by Aldermen Guindon and Lynch that the minutes of July 9th be adopted. Carried
- 5. Sewage Plant Expansion - Moved by Aldermen Pescod and Williamson that reports from the CAO and the Commissioner of Development, dated July 4th and July 2nd respectively, be received and that Administration be directed to proceed with further discussions with the Ministry as to the terms and conditions affecting the transfer of operations from the Ministry to the City of the existing facility to be tied to the schedule attached to the reports. Carried
- 6. Mini Putt, Broadview Park - Moved by Aldermen Guindon and LeBlanc that the City provide the site, give assistance in obtaining grants from other sources and render moral support in this project. Carried
- 7. Bill 46, Amendments to Municipal Act - Moved by Aldermen Lynch and Keen that the Ministry of Intergovernmental Affairs, the Municipal Liaison Committee and AMO be advised that Council does not support Section 3 of Bill 46. Carried
- 8. Travel Advances & Allowances - Moved by Aldermen Aubry and Keen that Financial Policy #19 be adopted.  
 After some discussion on the matter Aldermen Aubry and Keen withdrew their motion and it was then moved by Aldermen Lebano and Williamson that the report be referred back to Administration for further review. Carried
- 9. Fly Creek Flood Control - Moved by Aldermen Guindon and Samson that Council endorse Schedule I along with items 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5 of report from the CAO dated July 11th and forward same to the Ministry of Natural Resources through the Raisin Region Conservation Authority. Carried

COUNCIL

The Chairman of the Committee of the Whole reported to Council the actions of the Committee including the second reading of the by-laws and recommendations for enactment.

Committee of the Whole - Moved by Aldermen Lebano and LeBlanc that the Committee of the Whole be adopted. Carried

By-laws - Third Reading - Moved by Aldermen Lynch and Williamson that by-laws 93 to 95 as listed for third reading be taken as read a third time and finally passed. Carried

NEW OR UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Terry Fox - Moved by Aldermen Keen and Williamson that a telegram be forwarded to the Canadian Cancer Society asking them to convey to Terry Fox congratulations on behalf of Council and the citizens of Cornwall in his efforts to raise funds for research. Carried

Transit - Moved by Aldermen Lynch and Lalonde that transit drivers attempt to reserve the front seats for the elderly and the handicapped. Carried

Canadian Parks Association - Moved by Aldermen Lynch and Aubry that Council reconsider his decision to send 4 persons to the Canadian Parks Association Convention to be held in Halifax. The results of a recorded vote were as follows - For the Motion: Aldermen Armstrong, Pescod, Lalonde, Cameron, Lynch and Aubry. Against the Motion: Aldermen Lebano, Guindon, Keen, Williamson, Samson and LeBlanc. Defeated

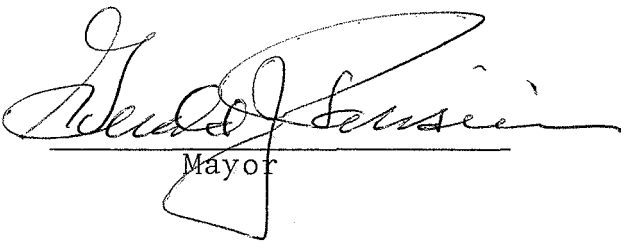
