

CITY COUNCIL #22-83

A Special Meeting of Council was held today when the following were present - His Worship Mayor G. Parisien, Aldermen R. Aubry, F. Guindon, R. Lalonde, T. Lalonde, A. Lebrano, A. LeBlanc, G. Leger, B. Lynch, E. Myers, J. Samis, G. Samson and W. Wise.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the construction of a sidewalk on Anthony Street.

Mr. Knight briefed Council on the construction of the sidewalk on Anthony Street in that it was considered a priority and Council included it in the 1983 Capital Budget. He stated that notice was given to the residents and no complaints were received. A second notice was given when the contractor was ready to commence work and no objections were received. However, the day after the work started the residents started to petition. Mr. Adams held a meeting with the residents and ude to opposition stopped the work. A petition was received prior to this meeting, with 93 names affixed, of persons in the immediate area who are in favour of the sidewalk. Mr. Knight indicated that approximately \$2,500 has already been spent on the construction and \$1,500 in resodding started.

Moved by Aldermen Wise and R. Lalonde that the City proceed with the construction of a sidewalk on Anthony Street and that the CAO explain his actions at the next Committee of Council. Carried


