Capital Budget 1983


Mayor Parisien explained that the current practice of increasing the yearly capital levy by 4 mills was proving to be successful and suggested that Council continue this practice.


Mr. McDonald, Commissioner of Finance, reviewed each section of the budget and with the assistance of the appropriate department heads gave explanations to questions posed by members of Council.

After considerable review and consideration, it was moved by Aldermen Wise and R. Lalonde that the City undertake a total of \$1,681,000 in capital works in 1983 plus a further \$290,000 in waterworks which is a self-liquidating enterprise; that of the \$1.68 million recommended for 1983 the Ontario Municipal Board be asked to give us a quota of \$750,000 and the balance of \$931,000 be paid for by current funds; that the current practice of increasing the yearly capital levy by four (4) mills be continued; and further that Administration investigate the possibility of replacing the sidewalk project on Seventh Street from the traffic circle to Hoople Avenue with the sidewalk project on Anthony Street from Second Street to Holy Cross Boulevard and that a report be submitted to Council.
