CAPITAL BUDGET

A Special Meeting of City Council was held this evening when the following were present - His Worship Mayor G. Parisien, Aldermen F. Guindon, R. Lalonde, T. Lalonde, A. Lebano, A. LeBlanc, G. Leger, B. Lynch, E. Myers, J. Pescod, J. Samis and W. Wise. Alderman Aubry was out of the city.


City Council reviewed with appropriate Department Heads the Capital Budget submissions which totalled \$2,371,000 plus a further \$327,000 for Waterworks which is self-liquidating. It was explained that if this proposed budget is accepted the financing would be as follows:


- a) Waterworks component by the issuance of debentures
- b) remaining improvements through the issuance of \$1,271,000 by debentures and \$1,100,000 from the revenue fund.

After considerable discussion it was moved by Aldermen R. Lalonde and Lynch that the Capital Budget for the year 1985 be approved as presented.
