By-law No. 40, 1985 - To authorize the signing of an agreement with St. Lawrence Power Company


Mr. Guilbeault, Vice-President and General Manager of St. Lawrence Power, explained that his company was successful in severing a parcel of land composed of part of Lot 7 on the north side of Seventh Street and part of Lot 7 on the south side of Eighth Street designated as parts 2 and 3 on Reference Plan 52R-2284. Their intention is to build a substation on this parcel. He advised that the Committee of Adjustment granted the severance on condition that St. Lawrence Power Company submit a site plan acceptable to the Planning Department and enter into an agreement with the City to execute the site plan as shown.


Miss Mary Purcell, City Planner, supports the site plan as presented by St. Lawrence Power. Mr. Guilbeault took note of the concerns expressed by certain members of Council and assured Council that the construction of this substation would be in accordance with the regulations and that extra monies would be spent to provide better accoustics to minimize the noise.

It was moved by Aldermen Pescod and Lynch that By-law No. 40, 1985 be given first, second and third reading and finally passed.
