C U R R E N T B U D G E T

A special meeting of City Council was held this evening when the following members were present: His Worship, Mayor Brian Lynch, Aldermen D. Aubry, T. Green, A. LeBlanc, D. Carr, G. Leger, C. Poirier, F. Guindon, C. Charlebois, R. Lalonde, B. Gallant, G. Grant and T. Lalonde.

Messrs Adams and F. McDonald introduced the budget document and reviewed with Council the net requirement of the budget book which is established at 8.1% increase in the mill rate. Mr. McDonald added that the Management Committee, upon further review of the book, wish to indicate to council, areas that the Committee feel Council could look at in an effort to reduce the mill rate increase. The areas include staffing, utilities, insurance, tourism, economic development, garage equipment, public works administration, contribution to the reserves, asphalt resurfacing, legal costs, arbitrations and grievances and public works. These areas total \$670,000 which could reduce the final mill rate to 4.5%.

Before council proceeded into reviewing each department budget,

It was moved by Aldermen Gallant and Charlebois that City Council not finalize any changes to the current budget or entertain any motions for changes until Council has had an opportunity to have an informal meeting to discuss the current budget on Saturday January 23rd.
