

CITY COUNCIL #11-91CURRENT BUDGET

March 21, 1991

A special meeting of City council was held with the following members present: His Worship, Mayor Phil Poirier, Aldermen T. Green, A. Leblanc, D. Carr, G. Leger, C. Poirier, A. Lebrano, R. Lalonde, and T. Lalonde.

Absent was Aldermen S. Backs and F. Guindon.

Also in attendance were the following Administrative Personnel: Mr. H.J. Cook, Chief Administrative Officer, Mr. J. Megill, Director Planning and Engineering, Mr. H. O'Reilly, Director Community Services, Mr. P. Fitzpatrick, Director Economic Development, Mr. F. McDonald, Director Finance and Administration, Mr. G. Kiviaho, Manager Human Resources, Mr. R. Cornwall Police Services Board

Alderman Guy Leger, Chairman, reviewed the Board's budget with Council and asked that Council add \$104,396 to the previously submitted budget.

Training & Development

Linda Sandelin, Training & Development Coordinator, explained to Council the various training budgets contained in her report.

Following this presentation, Council agreed to reconvene at 7:00 p.m. to continue with the Library Board presentation and other departmental budgets.

Library Board

Mr. Rolland Besner, Chairman, introduced Mr. Robert Hubscher, Chief Librarian, who proceeded to make a presentation to City Council. His presentation included a graph comparing expenditures between 1991 and 1990, a library material budget and a summary of 1989, 1990 and 1991 proposed budget of \$997,141.00. A discrepancy was noted between the City's budget amount and the Library's. Mr. Hubscher indicated that the discrepancy and other revised figures would be available for the next meeting.

CARRIED


Public Works
