

## **BYLAW 110, 1999**

### **OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF CORNWALL**

**BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND AN EXISTING DESIGNATING BYLAW WHICH DESIGNATES THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS 731 SECOND STREET WEST, AND COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE WOOD HOUSE MUSEUM, AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE OR INTEREST.**

**WHEREAS**, Section(s) 29 (and 31) of the Ontario Heritage Act authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact (and repeal) bylaws that designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest;

**AND WHEREAS**, no specific section of the Heritage Act identifies the process for amending an existing Designating Bylaw;

**AND WHEREAS**, as a result of consultation with representatives of the Ministry of Citizenship, Culture and Recreation, the Municipal Solicitor, and the Cornwall Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee (L.A.C.A.C.) it was determined that the procedure identified under Section 29 of the Act should be followed to amend an existing Designating Bylaw;

**AND WHEREAS**, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cornwall has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises located at 731 Second Street West (Domtar Fine Papers), and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, Notice of Intention to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the Municipality;

**AND WHEREAS**, no Notice of Objection to the proposed amendment to the Designating Bylaw has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cornwall enacts as follows:


1. **THAT** all reference in Bylaw No. 45, 1984 to the current Wood House site at **731 Second Street West** shall be amended to identify the new site in Lamoureux Park only, with municipal address being **160 Water Street West**, commencing on the actual day of the physical move of the structure;

2. THAT the locational descriptor found in Schedule "A" to Bylaw No. 45, 1984 shall effectively be amended commencing on the actual day of the physical move of the structure and shall read as follows:

"That specific portion of land on parts of Lots 10 and 11, Concession 1, in the City of Cornwall, County of Stormont, Province of Ontario, municipally referred to as 160 Water Street West, City of Cornwall;"

3. THAT the Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this Amending Bylaw to be served on the owner and registered against the deed of the aforementioned property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation. Also, to cause notice of the passing of this Amending Bylaw to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the Municipality.


